



**DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)
La Center Trail Improvements (File # 2016-002-SEPA)**

Description of proposal: Permit and construct multiple trail segments in the City of La Center. Segments include: Cafeteria Trail-Exhibit (approximately 1,100 lineal feet); New City Trail (approximately 500 lineal feet); High School Trail (approximately 900 to 1,250 lineal feet and a crossing over Brezee Creek); West Trail (approximately 170 lineal feet); Southwest Trail (approximately 600 lineal feet); New City Park Trail and Park (short section of gravel pedestrian trail on the west side of La Center Road Bridge and a new park on the east side of La Center Road just south of La Center Road Bridge).


